

## WORK CREW JOB DESCRIPTION Summer 2017

Members of the Work Crew are responsible for tasks related to camp maintenance, grounds keeping, and garbage removal. Members of Work Crew may also serve in the kitchen, as Health Hut Assistants, or Cabin Counselors if needed. Work Crew members enter fully into the life of the camp session at times outside of Work Crew duties. Work Crew members are responsible to the Maintenance Supervisor, the Summer Camp Coordinator, and the Head Counselor.

Specific responsibilities and duties for Work Crew are as follows:

- serve as a model of sacramental ministry to all campers and other staff
- provide feedback and assessment for staff members and summer camp program
- act as a role model and leader for the other Summer Staff members
- fulfill Support Staff role by partnering with/relieving Cabin Counselors
- fulfill Support Staff role by assisting with and participating in program activities and small groups (if schedule is conducive)
- fulfill Support Staff role by doing KP, pushing dishes, staffing canteen, helping with Pasture Party, and other tasks that fall within the scope of the Support Staff position
- cutting grass and weed eating
- collecting garbage and recycling materials
- help with construction projects
- set-up and clean-up at pasture parties
- clearing trails and fence lines
- working in the camp garden
- help in office, help in the kitchen, Health Hut, in a cabin
- vigilantly ensure the safety and well-being of campers occupying the same area
- other tasks as deemed appropriate in the scope of the position

Workpeople need to be able to:

- do hard, physical work in very hot weather
- maintain an impeccable standard of job safety
- receive instruction and follow direction
- consistently & enthusiastically participate in the larger community
